

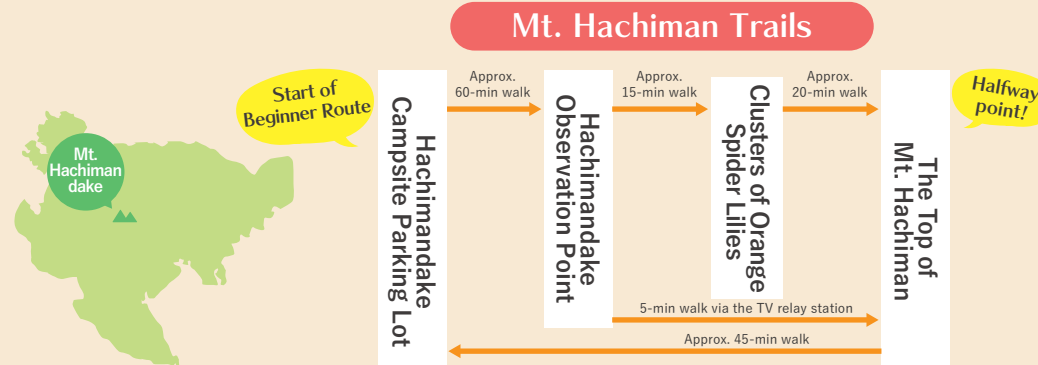

# Mt. Hachiman Area Guide Map



## Mt. Hachiman Trails Bask in the beauty of spectacular natural views

Mt. Hachiman (764m) is located on the border between Karatsu, Takeo, Taku and Imari in Saga Prefecture. It is said that the mountain's name comes from a story about how Chinzei Hachiro Tametomo built a small stone shrine for Hachimandake Daibosatsu, bodhisattva, at the summit. The main hiking route starts from the campsite parking lot — the most popular roundtrip route is to the summit via the observation point. The mountainous area that includes Mt. Hachiman and Mt. Onna (Mt. Funayama) was designated as the Hachimandake Prefectural Natural Park in 1970.



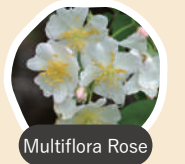

### 1 Hachimandake Campsite Parking Lot



A parking lot for about 40 cars is available near the campsite. Toilets are provided here, so you can easily set off on your hike.

### 2 Hachimandake Observation Point



This spot offers a panoramic view of the terraced rice fields of Warabino and beyond to the city of Karatsu and the Genkai Sea. It is possible to drive up to the observatory.

### 3 Clusters of Orange Spider Lilies



The best time to see these flowers is from late July to early August, when they are in full orange bloom.

### 4 The Top of Mt. Hachiman



From the summit (764m), enjoy views of Karatsu City and the Genkai Sea to the North, the Tara Mountains to the South, and Mt. Onna (Mt. Funayama) and Mt. Tenzan of the Hizen region to the East.
